

TYPICAL DRIP SYSTEM LAYOUTS

SURFACE WATER CHLORINATION

For best results; if using surface water, you should chlorinate your system every two weeks. Inject approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ Gal. chlorine bleach per acre. Run system about 20 minutes then let set for $\frac{1}{2}$ day before irrigating again.

HAVING TROUBLE GETTING THE HOSE OVER FITTINGS? TRY THIS...

- 1. Make two slits approximately 1" apart and 1" long, on each side of the hose end.
- **2.** Lubricate the inside of the hose and the outside of the fitting and set it upright on ground.
- **3.** Using two vise grips; clamp on the "flaps" and wobble the hose back and forth over the fitting as shown at right.
